

## DRIVER/MEDIC

Chena-Goldstream Fire & Rescue is seeking an individual with Fire and EMS experience, to fill an Apparatus Driver/Medic role. This position will work a rotating 48/96 shift. In this role, you have the opportunity to showcase your leadership skills, as this position will be focused on: building collaborative, positive relationships and mentoring staff, volunteers and students; recognition and leadership building; fire service leadership; and emergency medical services.

### **TYPICAL DUTIES INCLUDE:**

- Emergency Response to alarms and assist in the operation of emergencies to include entry and direction of emergency crews.
- Assist with the development of manuals, courses, classes and other training methods utilizing and developing personnel resources within CGFR and outside agencies.
- Identify and advise company officers of training problems and implement solutions.
- Assist with the recruitment and retention of new and assigned volunteers.
- Instruct initial and make up recruit classes.
- Assist in carrying out operations of the fire department.
- Fill in as "Acting Shift Officer" as needed.

  - State of Alaska EMT II (EMT III and Current lead medic preferred)
  - Hazardous Materials Operations certificate
  - I-100, I-200, I-700 certificates
  - Valid Alaska Driver's License
  - Any other certifications pertinent to the position
4. Copy of Driving Record.
5. Copy of Criminal History Record.

Should you be chosen for the interview and assessment center, the following events will take place;

- Candidate is interviewed.
- Recruit Training Scenario: Candidate will conduct a 15-minute presentation on a FFI topic. (This task will demonstrate skill in training of recruits)
- Written test consisting of FFI, EMT I and basic driver/pumper knowledge.
- Physical agility test

The final results will be reviewed by the Fire Chief.

Employment offer for the Driver/Medic position will be contingent upon passing a department physical agility test, drug test, physician physical and background check.
