

Chena-Goldstream Fire & Rescue is seeking an individual for a position with Fire and EMS experience, at the Company Officer's level, to serve as a Shift Officer with other assigned responsibilities. (See packet for more information). We are looking for career minded individuals with a potential long-term commitment to our department. Salary is DOE and rank of Lieutenant or Captain is dependent on experience with a benefits package and reimbursement for moving expenses up to \$10,000 (with receipts).

In this role, you have the opportunity to showcase your leadership skills, as this position will be focused heavily on: building collaborative, positive relationships and mentoring staff, volunteers and students; recognition and leadership building; fire service leadership; and emergency medical services.

 - Valid Alaska Driver's License
 - Any other certifications pertinent to the position
4. Copy of Driving Record.
5. Copy of Criminal History Record.

This Position is open until filled. Should you be chosen for an interview, the following events will take place;

- Candidate is interviewed.
- Candidate will instruct a ten (10) minute class on a topic that is in the State of Alaska. Firefighter 1 curriculum. Please use PowerPoint to accompany your presentation.
- Candidate will demonstrate skills as an Incident Commander on multiple Type 5 emergencies.

- Candidate will demonstrate EMS skills in a simulated medical or trauma scenario.
- Candidate will write up a fire report on a specified incident.
- Candidate will be administered a 100 question, multiple choice, written exam which will touch on general knowledge areas of FF1& II, Field Hydraulics, EMT I, II, III, Hazmat Ops and Leadership.
- Candidate will be required to pass the department physical agility test.

The final results will be reviewed by the Fire Chief.

Employment offer for the Shift Officer positions will be contingent upon passing a drug test, physician physical and background check. First Review Date 9/1.
